Years ago, amid turmoil and serious wrestling in my spirit, I lay down on a lawn one afternoon wondering what God would have me do as I considered full time ministry. I had just graduated from a Bible School. The fiery war of independence engulfed my country of Zimbabwe. The calling to reach the lost with the pure and simple Gospel was compellingly strong.

The church leadership, however, had not yet invited me to serve in any capacity, and that became an opening through which the Devil attacked me.

He sowed seeds of doubt about my value as a person, about my faith, about my calling and about my future. The more I listened to his lies, the more despondent I became. Finally, I cried to God to speak to me. I heard Him say, "Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for him...." My heart quieted and I breathed a deep sigh of relief. Ever since that experience I have learned to walk every step of life by faith.

When I joined hands with Ron Susek as the Global Director of FaithWalk Ministries International (the new ministry started under the Susek Evangelistic Association), we prayerfully stated our vision as: To equip one million Christians worldwide to bring 100 million people to salvation through the pure and simple gospel.

To have such a vision is not a blind leap into the dark, but an act of faith. We believe this is not our vision alone, but one for the entire body of Christ in this time and age. We know that to realize the fruits of this vision will take both prayer and financial support from you who believe one soul is eternally priceless.
