

ASSYRIAN AWAKENING



The daily news presents a harbinger of hell on earth. The stirring of the Assyrian prophecy, however, suggests that

God's Kingdom is drawing near. Who are the Assyrians? What is the prophecy?

Assyria's epic story is mysteriously unknown. But her dawn of awakening is breaking across the horizon.

For centuries, savage cruelty has driven into obscurity these descendants of a once great empire. Media uses the term minority, which renders them nameless, faceless and unnecessary. But the day is rapidly approaching when the prophecy that includes their name will be fulfilled, and the world will know who they are.

Strangely, even the Church has overlooked Isaiah's prophecy that casts Assyria in an end-time role with Israel and Egypt to worship God and bless the world.

Light is dispelling the darkness and the earth is trembling with anticipation as the Assyrian awakening spreads, signaling the Messiah's soon return.

To discover how highly heaven esteems the Assyrians, we need only consider how highly Jesus valued them. Twice, Jewish leaders requested a sign to prove that He was the Son of God. One time, Jesus shocked them by answering, "An evil and adulterous generation seeks for a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of Jonah."

Yes, you read it right. Jesus called them evil. He declared their unfaithfulness to God adulterous. Jesus was obviously more committed to truth than making friends and influencing people. smiled to hear Him mention the Jewish prophet, Jonah. But the next part shocked them into grinding their teeth and gasping for air. Jesus said, "The men of Nineveh will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and behold, something greater than Jonah is here."

That wiped all smiles away. Jesus had just elevated the men of Nineveh (the Assyrians) to judge and

condemn this generation. Surely this provoked a frenzy of kicking dust, blowing air and spewing threats.

How does this matter to us? If Jesus elevated the Assyrians of Jonah's day to judge the Jewish leaders of His day, how dare we toss these people onto the trash heap of history? The fact that they went from a mighty empire to a broken and betrayed nation does not suggest Divine abandonment.

Here is history that has been robbed from us. Shortly after Jesus' resurrection, three disciples took the Gospel to the

Assyrians, resulting in the entire nation choosing to follow the Savior. The Assyrians became the greatest voice of the Gospel for centuries, spreading the truth of salvation from Mesopotamia to China and elsewhere, leaving millions of converts in their path. Their evangelistic zeal led to numerous martyrs spilling their blood for the cause of Christ.

THE PROPHECY

In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and Assyria will come into Egypt, and Egypt into Assyria, and the Egyptians will worship with the Assyrians.

In that day Israel will be the third with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth, whom the LORD of hosts has blessed, saying, "Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel my inheritance."

~Isaiah 19:23-25

On another occasion the same request drew a worse blistering. Jesus said, "... as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."

That part probably flew right past the Jewish leaders. Perhaps they

Their majestic history is eye opening. If one or two Bible stories are all you know about the Assyrians, then you have only a few scenes of a feature length movie that sweeps across 4,000 years. Truth is, their monumental history is the story of God's everlasting love, magnificent redemption and exalted end-time purpose.

No valley of pain can match the one they have walked in preparation for their high role in the end. Consider this part of their history. For six to seven centuries, coming right down to 2014 when ISIS attacked them in northern Iraq, they have suffered untold losses. Picture yourself walking past the empty bedroom of your beloved daughter who was abducted, raped and sold into sex slavery. Imagine seeing the plowshare that your son once walked behind before being murdered. Think of seeing the bodies of your forefathers godlessly stacked for mass burial in an unmarked grave. Consider your reaction to be driven from your home with no judicial recourse. Try to comprehend living amid a sea of people seeking to exterminate you.

This is not an imaginary drama. This is factual history. Assyrians have worn a target on their backs for centuries simply for being Christians.



Why do the powers of hell hate them so deeply? Two reasons: First, their message is the cross of love and not the sword of hate. Second, when the prophecy is fulfilled, Satan will be chained in the pit for one thousand years. Midnight is approaching. Hell is raging.

You may wonder why you have never heard them cry out for help.

They have—repeatedly! With dry throats and hoarse voices, they have sought justice from world leaders. Doors were opened but hearts were closed. Promises were followed by betrayals, knowing that massacres would result.

Following WWI, Lord Halifax articulated Britain's corrupt betrayal of the Assyrians by saying, "At times moral considerations must give way to imperial policy."

Assyrian activist, David Perley, exposed the conflicting forces between true Christianity and corrupt government by writing, "... there are two antagonistic forces...which are in conflict with one another: one is the force of spiritualism and of everlasting values,

and the other is the force of sheer materialism and of contemporary expediency."

Perley adds, "Relying upon certain promises, the Assyrians gave their loyal service to the British. To that end, they sacrificed their all and were reduced to a state of virtual annihilation."

This brings us to a crossroads. Will we stand with our brothers and sisters in Christ or join the feckless wretches who simply look away?

For 2,700 years God shielded His end-time prophecy to await its time. Now, the shadow of God's hand is receding as the breaking light is forecasting Christ's soon return. The Assyrians were the great voice of the Gospel at the start of the Church age and so shall they be at the end.

Prophecies show us where God is going so that we can go with Him. Jesus taught us to pray for God's will in heaven to manifest on earth. He also taught us to stand firm with love for one another. You are needed to help spread the Assyrian awakening.


On March 3, 2020, Senator Barto presented "Proclamation HCR 2006" acknowledging the Assyrian Genocides of 1915. As



DAWN OF A NEW ASSYRIAN ERA



Being an Assyrian, my heart longs for God's prophecy given to Isaiah to be fulfilled. On that day, Assyria will be peacefully settled in my homeland serving the Messiah,

Jesus Christ, along with Israel and Egypt.

Today, however, my precious nation is struggling with internal divisions and external attacks, resulting in fading hope and drifting from our historic Christian faith.

Our culture and faith were once entwined as tightly as one's body and spirit. Now, many youth are drifting away from the truth. Being scattered worldwide is like tossing a brick through a stained-glass window. The unified message appears as broken shards on the ground.

We are speaking different languages, absorbed in diversified cultures and lured away from biblical beliefs. The enemy's effort to strip us of our commitment to righteousness and truth is palpable. He would succeed except for God's providence.

Assyrians have always overcome challenges by faith. Centuries of injustice, oppression, abduction, rape and martyrdom, however, have for many worn threadbare the fabric of faith. Being ignored as though we do not exist is causing many to stop believing in themselves. Disheartened, they have lost sight of the continuous miracle of our very existence. Hope in God's prophetic plan has faded.

Do not get me wrong. Most Assyrians would never surrender their faith in Christ. Hope for our future existence, however, is constantly rocked by contentious divisions. Although we created the "Cradle of Civilization," it is hard for many to see God preparing us to bless the world.

Then, a man with a message of hope emerged seemingly from nowhere. Enter Dr. Ron Susek... author of "*The Assyrian Prophecy*." Through this book, God is awakening the mighty spirits of the descendants of ancient Nineveh. They feel reassured that God has not forsaken them,

despite continued abandonment by the world.

If the nations viewed my people through the lens of biblical prophecy, all would change overnight. Our place in prophecy did not end at Assyria's collapse in 612 B.C. A little more than half a century later, the very nation that repented at Jonah's preaching placed their faith in Jesus Christ.

The Ancient Path of Authority

The serpent who lured our first parents—Adam and Eve—to rebel against God's word of authority has been slithering throughout the world spreading the same lies that

throughout the world spreading the same lies that he told them. "You will not die, but rather you will be like God."

One of his greatest lies has been to create the illusion that you can use authority for self-advancement and go unpunished. Authority begins with God, and when abused, the wrath of God is awakened.

Just because a fool violates authority does not justify the destruction of authority. That would be like trying to eliminate air because someone polluted it. No one lives without air. No one accomplishes things of eternal value without authority.

A patriarchal position of authority is best represented by the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. Here you find God's Son washing feet, binding wounded hearts, forgiving repentant sinners, rebuking wolves in sheep's clothing, and in the end taking the sin of the world upon Himself.

He knew that all authority resides in His Father. Thus, He claimed to do nothing by Himself. He only spoke what His Father told Him to say and did only what He saw His Father doing.

As a result, He was given the authority to defeat Satan, redeem mankind and rule over the coming Kingdom of God. The heart of true authority is not to elevate oneself at the expense of another, but to sacrificially give of oneself to lift another.

It can be said that you can only exercise authority to the degree you are first submitted to it. Once you submit to Divine authority, there is no limit as to what God may empower you to do.


The Assyrian Awakening is revealing a people who have never departed from God's command in Jeremiah 6:16, which reads,

A PATRIARCH IMPACTS TODAY'S WORLD



March 3, 1918. At age 31, Patriarch Benyamin Shimun XXI was assassinated. The demise of him and forty-eight of his guards was plotted by an exceedingly evil

man named, Isael Agha Simko, whose name is an evil stain on the pages of history.

Simko lured Patriarch Mar Benyamin into a trap, saying he wanted to establish an alliance with the Assyrian people. Following a favorable meal and discussion, Simko showered Mar Benyamin with compliments while escorting him to his coach, then faded into the background.

Suddenly, Simko's armed forces opened fire massacring the Patriarch and forty-eight of his guards. Two escaped and gave eyewitness accounts.

The Assyrians were already bearing deep sorrow over the hundreds of thousands of relatives, who had been senselessly massacred at the end of WWI. Now their young Patriarch lay dead, his body riddled with bullets.

It was in this dark hour that the new Patriarch, Mar Poulus Shimun, stood before his broken people who gathered to hear him at a refugee camp in

Baquba. He bore a double burden as the murdered Patriarch was his brother. Amazingly, his words towered among the greatest messages of all time. Here is what he said:

"Beloved sons in the Lord: By the grace of God I have been called to occupy the Patriarchal See of the Eastern Church. I do, however, confess my weakness, and declare to you that the sacred service is far above my feeble strength. The tremendous responsibility becomes particularly great now when our Church and our Nation are face to face with a terrible crisis. Without your assistance, the task will be entirely too great for me.

"However, I am not seeking your assistance in word only, but also in your deeds and in your Christian conduct. You and I must together keep close to the mercy seat of Christ, that he may enable us to

conduct both the affairs of the Church and the Nation in accordance with His own holy will. The Holy Scriptures are full of promises for us if we only ask by faith. However, corresponding with our humble petitions and our declaration of dependence upon the Lord, there must also appear the beauty of our Christian conduct and our Christian life.

"Our history of sixteen centuries should be a lesson to us. During the long ages that are past we have suffered afflictions, persecutions, and massacres, which are beyond the power of human pen to describe, and yet we have not been consumed.

"We have been preserved and kept by a mighty hand and by a holy will. This should be an assurance for us that God the Father has a holy purpose concerning us. And the purpose must surely be that we may become a light and a blessing to the millions of our race who still remain far away from the truth of the Gospel. When we have understood this well, we learn that we must not depend upon the arm of flesh or upon the


power of man. Our hope and our trust must always be in the Lord and in Him only.

"We should also remember the commandment of our Savior, to love one another and to be kind and merciful toward our enemies. We should abstain from revenge and should be willing and ready to forgive those who have done us great evil. We must remember that plunder is an abomination to the Lord and must keep our hands clean from possessing that which does not belong to us, even though we have been robbed, we have been plundered and we have been deprived of our homes and of all our possessions. It is our duty to defend ourselves as a nation and protect the sanctity of our family shrines, but we must also recall that our main mission in the world is to make known the name of our Christ and to reveal the spirit of His Gospel among the races and the nations who know Him not. This we must do, not by a mere profession of our lips, but by a conduct dominated by a heart filled with His love.

"We are compelled to defend ourselves, as I have said before, and to preserve our national existence. This task may demand greater hardships yet, and greater sacrifices. Perhaps we have not given enough blood yet, nor has our capacity for suffering and sacrifice been filled to its full measure. But in all circumstances, we must keep in our mind the fact that all true greatness is in one's kindly feeling toward his enemies. Such was the spirit of the lamented Mar Benyamin Shimun. Let the sweet example of his life dominate our attitude toward those who hate us. He died, [giving] his life for the flock he so dearly loved. Let us honor his sweet memory by loving one another, and by being kind toward our enemies. I, Poulus Shimun, your Patriarch, and leader, beseech of you all and ask of each and all of you, to become true witnesses of your holy profession.

"The blessing of the Lord be upon you all. Amen!"

Rethink the highlighted parts. They reveal Assyria's true soul. Her history flows like a river of blood. Her present is a precarious path of national separation. Her future is flooded with promise. God calls her, *Assyria*, the work of my hands. Clearly, He is shaping her, along with Israel and Egypt, for worldwide authority under the Messiah. Many people are awakening to the prophecy. This is the time for every perceptive believer to stand with Assyria as God raises her up as a mighty end-time voice of the Gospel.



FAITH VS. REALITY

And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

~Hebrews 11:6

God's word in heaven is generally opposed by reality on earth. When God says, "It shall be," reality says, "It shall not be."

This war began with Adam's fall. God said, "Don't" and Satan said, "Do." Adam faced a choice of faith; whose word would he believe?

That same choice falls upon you and me over and over again in life. God gives revelation of what He is going to do. Satan arranges reality to prove God a liar.

Truth be told, reality can change in a heartbeat, but God's word is eternal. The Bible gives a long list of examples of people who chose to believe God despite the stubborn resistance of reality, all of whom won!

Noah, for instance, faced one hundred and twenty years of mockery because he was building an ark when no one had ever seen a drop of rain. The earth's torn up crust reveals that Noah's faith won over reality.

Abraham is another. By faith, he departed a comfortable life in Ur to follow God. Reality must have been doing a belly laugh when Abraham ended up in a desert of drought. Yes, the Patriarch weakened and went to

Egypt for relief. There, he nearly lost his wife and his life. Lesson learned, he went on to believe God for the impossible, including the birth of Isaac when both he and Sarah were beyond reproductive years. He learned the lesson of faith strongly enough to become the father of nations.

David lived a life of putting his faith up against impossible odds—and winning. The reality of his brothers tried to stop him from going up against a giant. He went on by faith to face the reality of King Saul who wanted to kill him, opposing nations that wanted to dethrone him and a son who wanted to eliminate him. In the end, his faith so drove him to seek God that he became known in heaven as a friend of God, so much so that the coming Messiah will reign from his throne.

So, where does that bring us in light of Isaiah's prophecy? Once again, faith believes the coming fulfillment of the prophecy and reality declares it to be impossible.

Our first instinct could be to seek a compromise, as though God's eternal word and reality's momentary opposition can shake hands. Can the invaders who stole the land where God established Assyria be appeased? Or are God's declarations exacting? Think about it. Did God send Moses into Egypt to make a deal with the Pharaoh? Or, did he give the Pharaoh an ultimatum that was backed by heaven? Everyone knows the end of that story.

And what about Cyrus? When he conquered the Babylonians, he inherited all the Jewish slaves that they had previously captured. Did God offer Cyrus money to let them return to Jerusalem? Not a penny. In fact, it was Cyrus, a man who knew not God, that said God told him to send the Jews home. He even financed their massive effort and gave them a military escort to return safely to their homeland.

Now, faith and reality are colliding once again. We know from Isaiah's prophecy that a literal highway will run from Assyria, through Israel and into Egypt. We know that Assyria and Egypt will be worshipping together, quite probably in Jerusalem with the Jews. We know that the three nations will be a source of profound blessing to the entire world.

Reality has built a wall named "Impossible" to make mockery of the prophecy. Once again, we all face the choice of faith. Whose voice will we believe? God's word or that of reality?

... will Assyria ever be home?

I choose God's word with no compromise or negotiated conditions.

Here is what we can know for certain. God is a just judge who loves the entire world. The invaders of Assyria's homeland are as deeply loved by God as are the Assyrians. God will care for them. The faster their occupiers obey God and hand the land back to the Assyrians the greater God will bless and care for them. The longer they take the worse it will get.

Ask the Pharaoh.

Keep in mind that Armageddon is coming. The global meltdown is on its way. God is going to hold every nation responsible for its sins. Every hidden motive, every injustice, every betrayal, every murder, every rape, every enslavement—everything will brought into the light and judged by God's Son.

In that day, every "reality" that opposed God will be laid

bare. When God rises from His throne and speaks a word it never returns void. Reality may belittle faith for the moment but they who hope in the Lord will never be put to shame.

This leads us to an allimportant point revealed in Hebrews 11:1-3, which reads,

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the people of old received their commendation. By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

Simply put, faith lives today as though the future God promised was already here. This may draw great laughter from the world. So be it; faith speaks openly of what God says and lives to see the day when reality surrenders to His mighty hand.



MAN ON A MISSION

The story begins when, as a boy, Sabri Atman heard the oral accounts of the persecutions, abductions, rapes and murders of his Assyrian people at the end of WWI. One story in particular haunts him

to this day. Assyrians were being deported by foot from the Ottoman Empire to the Syrian desert. The military that led the forced march would permit feudal landowners to choose and enslave any Assyrian they wanted.

One brutal landowner glared at a mother holding her little girl named Sarah. He saw the child as a bride for eventually making babies and a worker in his fields. With a heart hollowed by hell, he tore Sarah from her mother's arms and walked away.

Sarah's mother slumped to the ground wailing in desperation for him to return Sarah to her arms. With eyes blurred from tears, she watched until her precious child was gone from sight—forever. Feeling the weight of having all human rights robbed, the Assyrians were forced to move on.

This, and many other equally compelling reports, shaped Sabri Atman's life's mission.

Mr. Atman knows that evil cannot be placated. It must be stopped. He is aware that evil grows best when planted in darkness, and that only the light of truth can end it. This fuels his relentless mission to bring justice to Assyria's past and security for her future.

There are two forces that make his mission exceedingly difficult. One is that people suffering under such tyranny have no ability to raise their voices on behalf of the Assyrian cause. The second is that those who are living in freedom rarely sacrifice their time and comfort to stand with the

helpless. Truth is, evil can be stopped when enough average people with brave hearts make their voices heard.

Hence, Mr. Atman's mission is to tenaciously shine the light of truth into the dark dungeon of evil. He is calling for justice for past crimes, which is a Divine requirement that has heaven's full support. Justice can remove some of the pain inflicted in the past, but also offer protection for Assyria's return to her God-given homeland

established by God some 4000 years ago. Assyria will then be positioned for her millennial role to join Israel and Egypt in worshipping God and blessing the world.

Few people possess the steel-like courage with which Atman speaks. Amazingly, however, his affable personality exudes warmth, love and respect for all people.

Born in a tiny village of Arbo¹ in southeast Turkey, he has earned three Master's degrees and started an organization called the Seyfo² Center with chapters in various parts of the world. Their noble objective is to dispel darkness by the light of truth about the genocides waged against Assyrians to clear a path for justice to be served.

Atman is currently working on a Doctorate degree in genocide at the University of Texas at Dallas. His mentor, Dr. David Patterson, is an expert on Jewish studies and the Holocaust. Sabri's name will certainly be etched in marble in the soon

rebuilding of Assyria in her homeland.

The Seyfo Centers are working tirelessly to raise awareness about Assyria's history and especially the genocides committed against her. The Seyfo Center efforts, along with other Assyrian organizations, have resulted in six American states recognizing Assyria and the genocides. The six states are California, Arizona, New York, Illinois, Iowa and Indiana. More may be added in the coming year.

AN AFRICAN LEADER TALKS ABOUT ASSYRIA



The Isaiah 19:23–25 passage has been part of the scriptures from time immemorial. Many of us, surprisingly, have glanced over the prophecy many times without pausing to think and reflect upon it. It is as if it



has been hidden from our eyes. Historical accounts have that tendency. They live in their past until they "bomb" our present and come alive.

This interesting prophecy has been resting dormant in the pages of scripture for years and biblical scholars, as if afraid of its significance in the whole plan of God, never esteemed its primary chair among the great prophecies in scripture.

All we can say is that everything has a season! God's timing is always the best. The Isaiah prophecy is now emerging from the pages of scripture and is bringing much excitement among many of us. It has created a 'Wow' feeling among scripture lovers. Many of us are asking, "Why have we not seen this before?" We have given little to no thought about the Assyrian people because we never thought they belonged to the present. Thus, very little has been said about them.

The book by Dr. Ron Susek, *The Assyrian Prophecy*, has generated new interest worldwide in

this lost nation. The book has suddenly put a face to people who for years have been scattered and assimilated in various parts of the world. It is a people that awaits to be gathered, not by human design, but by God's sovereign will to become a nation fulfilling God's purposes and plan. 

Discovering the Real You

Finding God's Gift of Well-being

It is my sincere hope that you will not feel that I am less involved in your life by talking to you through a video and manual. I am giving to you the best information I know, whether it be in person or through this video series. Even if you were sitting across from my desk, having a face-to-face counseling session, you would have to do the same thing when you left my office as you will when you finish this course—apply this material!

Unfortunately, what is lost by not meeting with you in person is my sharing in the joy you will experience as God works His truth in your life as you apply this information. I hope you will take the time to write to me and share how God has been using this series to accomplish great things for you.

Socrates said, *know thyself*. The fact is that many people go through life never understanding what makes them think and feel the way they do. We all experience the Apostle Paul's feeling of bewilderment described in Romans chapter seven: For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing (vs.18b -19). The main difference between Paul and the majority of people is that Paul clearly understood the cause of the struggle, as well as the comfort of the solution.

Early in this series, we deal with the "Line of Reality" or normalcy. This will give us a standard to follow. We need to understand God's original intention for us.

Then we will look at where we are from a biblical perspective. We will see the severe complexity of problems that have and can enter our lives as a result of sin from within or from the sin of others.

Finally, we will see the biblical solution. It will be the same one found by the Apostle Paul.

I have come to realize the majority of our problems can be resolved by a proper relationship with God. Each of us is on our own unique journey of coming to God's resolutions to our problems. That path will be quite different for an incest victim, for example, than it will be for a person who experienced a different kind of loss. We must be very sensitive to the unique difficulties each person has in working his or her way to understanding God's solutions for their lives.

There is an explanation given in this series as to why some may seek God to resolve a particular problem and not find the answer they want immediately. I hope those who are still waiting on the answer will find courage and determination in this section.

Some of the discoveries shared include:

DISCOVERY TRUTH #1:

God is in the business of character building, not quickfix solutions to our problems.

DISCOVERY TRUTH #2:

If we evolved from animals, we must look down to the animals to understand our behavior. However, when we turn to the Bible, we discover that that is not the picture at all. Rather, we fell from God and the only way we can understand ourselves is to look up to God and see how far we have fallen.

DISCOVERY TRUTH #3:


The harder you try to feel good about yourself, the more you are focused on self. The more you are focused on self—that, my friend, is idolatry. The more you focus on yourself, trying to feel good about yourself, the deeper you go into your problems.
